A Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols

In 1880 E.W. Benson, then Anglican Bishop of Truro, England, composed a Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols, based on ancient sources, for Christmas Eve. In 1918 it was adopted for the chapel of King's College, Cambridge, by its dean, Eric Milner-White, who also wrote The Bidding Prayer.

Today, on this fifth day of Christmas, we have adapted and modernized this service for our church family at First Methodist Church Washington. While the lessons were first conceived to be read aloud in a cathedral setting, we hope that through this contemporary version the eternal words of God may connect with our lives through the music shared. The carols or songs that are used today may be familiar to some of you, with some old favorites and new favorites. Our hope is that this festival today will revive the biblical story of the incarnation and birth of Jesus Christ in your lives, and rekindle the Christmas story in your spirit.
